

St. Paul Greeting Ministry

Thank you for volunteering for this important and wonderful ministry in our parish. This is new for all of us as we begin to celebrate in a new worship space, so please bear with us as we work through the process.

Here are some general guidelines to follow:

1. Arrive at your scheduled mass 20-30 minutes before mass begins.
2. Retrieve a nametag from the greeter's basket in the sacristy (an envelope is there this weekend) and return it after mass. In the future we will have specific nametags.
3. 2 families/individuals are scheduled for each mass. One can be at the center/main entrance doors and another can be at the side doors (parking lot and activity center). If there are enough people, have a greeter at each side door.
4. Familiarize yourself with where the Restrooms are located.
5. Find an usher if someone needs help with wheelchair seating.
6. There is no cry room. Parents can hear the mass in the vestibule if they need to take their child out of church.
7. There is no Angel Room right now. They need a volunteer to run it, so hopefully in the future there will be one.
8. You can say a variety of greetings: "Welcome to church!" "Welcome to St. Paul Church!" "Hi, Good Morning" or "Hi, Good Afternoon!"
9. SMILE! Speak loudly, as this is a large space and it is filled with voices and movement.

Finally, enjoy this ministry! You may be surprised at how much your smile and kindness bring to others. 😊
